



PROJECT TIMELINE





DRAFT RECOMMENDATIONS

Considerations:

How much funding is available for new projects?



Available funding = Projected transit tax revenue (based on GoTriangle financial model) - Already-programmed services and capital investments

Project Priorities:

- Unfunded or emerging priority projects (from SRTPs)
- Meets needs expressed by public
- Reflects community values (equity; sustainability; economic prosperity; affordable and attainable quality of life; and transportation and access for all)
- Fills regional connectivity gap







DRAFT RECOMMENDATIONS

Two project types:

- Shorter-term (present 2030), funded with projected transit tax revenues
- Longer-term (2030 and beyond), conceptual vision, not yet programmed

Five (5) recommended service improvement projects and two (2) recommended capital projects focusing on:

- Increased frequency
- Longer service hours
- Service on more days per week
- Targeted pedestrian, bus shelter, and roadway improvements



	OCPT MOD	Run service 2 days per week, per zone
Triangle	US 15-501 Projects	 GoTriangle route 400/405 consolidation and midday frequency improvements CHT D route extension to Patterson Place CHT J route peak and midday frequency improvements



CONCEPTUAL TRANSIT VISION MAP






CURRENT PHASE: ENGAGEMENT
