 SUBJECT: FY21 & 22 Call for Projects – Changes in Funding Availability

The North Carolina Department of Transportation has provided DCHC MPO with revised Surface Transportation Block Grant Direct Attributable (STBGDA) and Transportation Alternatives Program Direct Attributable (TAPDA) funding amounts, which has resulted in the increased availability of federal funding for the FY21 & 22 call for projects.

Additional funding has become available due to:

- 1) Prior year closeout
- 2) NCDOT has increased the obligation ceiling for STBGDA and TAPDA funding in FY21 from 90 percent to 98 percent

STBGDA – Local Discretionary

- Staff applied the local discretionary distribution formula to the revised STBGDA funding available, which has increased funding available to municipalities.
- Counties receive a distribution based on the first \$500,000 of STBGDA funding, and therefore have already received the maximum amount of STBGDA possible.
- A 20 percent local match is required for these funds.

STBG-Competitive (formerly Any Area)

- NCDOT has determined that DCHC MPO has \$607,314 of unobligated STBGDA funds from FY20.
- This funding has been added to the Any Area funding pool for distribution.
- A 20 percent local match is required for these funds.

Regional Bicycle and Pedestrian

- Raising the obligation ceiling for FY21 TAPDA and STBGDA funding has resulted in the increased availability of Regional Bike-Ped funding.
- DCHC has not received a TAPDA allocation for FY22.
- A 20 percent local match is required for these funds.
