

RESOLUTION TO ENDORSE REGIONAL BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN FUNDING PROPOSALS FOR FY 2018-19

October 10, 2018

A motion was made by MPO Board Member _____ and seconded by MPO Board Member _____ for the adoption of the following resolution, and upon being put to a vote, was duly adopted.

WHEREAS, the Fixing America’s Surface Transportation (FAST) Act includes funding for the Surface Transportation Block Grant-Direct Attributable (STBGDA) program as well as funding for activities as in the Transportation Alternatives Program-Direct Attributable (TAP-DA); and

WHEREAS, the DCHC MPO distributes the STBGDA and TAP-DA funds within its jurisdiction through an allocation to regional bicycle and pedestrian projects; and

WHEREAS, the FAST Act makes TAP-DA funds not obligated by September 30, 2019 subject to possible rescission; and

WHEREAS, the DCHC MPO Board wishes to utilize as efficiently as possible the STBGDA and TAP-DA funding it has been granted; and

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro Metropolitan Planning Organization Board endorses the use STBGDA and TAP-DA funds through the regional bike/ped allocation for projects EB-4707A, Old Durham Road, and EB-4707B, Old Chapel Hill Road, as listed in the attachment, here on this, the 10th day of October, 2018.
