



## **US 70 Corridor Study Background and Update**



- Traditional corridor study, moving away from access and connectivity focus
- Boulevard conversion:
  - Summarize existing challenges to boulevard conversion
  - Interchanges and/or grade-separation
  - Existing and Future analysis with multimodal focus
- Evaluate potential impact on sustainable and equitable transportation networks
- Completion data of Spring 2023 not altered
- DCHC MPO staff actively assist consultant, provide data and modeling support
- Coordinating with NCDOT as an active partner
