What is the Coordinated Human Services-Public Transit Plan?



- Federally required for use of section 5310 funds (Enhanced Mobility for Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities)
 - These are Durham UZA funds in which the City of Durham is the designated recipient
- Improves mobility by removing barriers to transportation and expands options
- Must include participation from:
 - Seniors
 - Individuals with disabilities
 - Representatives of public, private, and nonprofit transportation and human services providers

*Note: Each urban region has a plan and rural areas without a plan are currently being consolidated in the Statewide Coordinated Plan

What Were the Main Outcomes from the Last Update?

 - Coordination/Mobility Hub for Human Services and Public Transportation
 - Expanded Transportation Services
 - Expanded Education Services
 - Application Process Improvements (passengers applying for service)
 - Bus Stop Access Improvements
- Funded Projects
 - 2016/2018/2020/2022: EZ Rider Senior Shuttle (Orange County)
 - 2016/2018/2020/2022: Orange County STEAMM Mobility Manager
 - 2016/2018/2020/2022: GoDurham ACCESS ADA Trips Beyond ³/₄ Miles
 - 2016/2018/2020: GoDurham County Access for Demand Response Service within the County
 - 2018/2020: CHT ADA Bus Stop Review and Design Work
 - DCHC MPO Administration
