DCHC MPO Locally Administered Projects Program

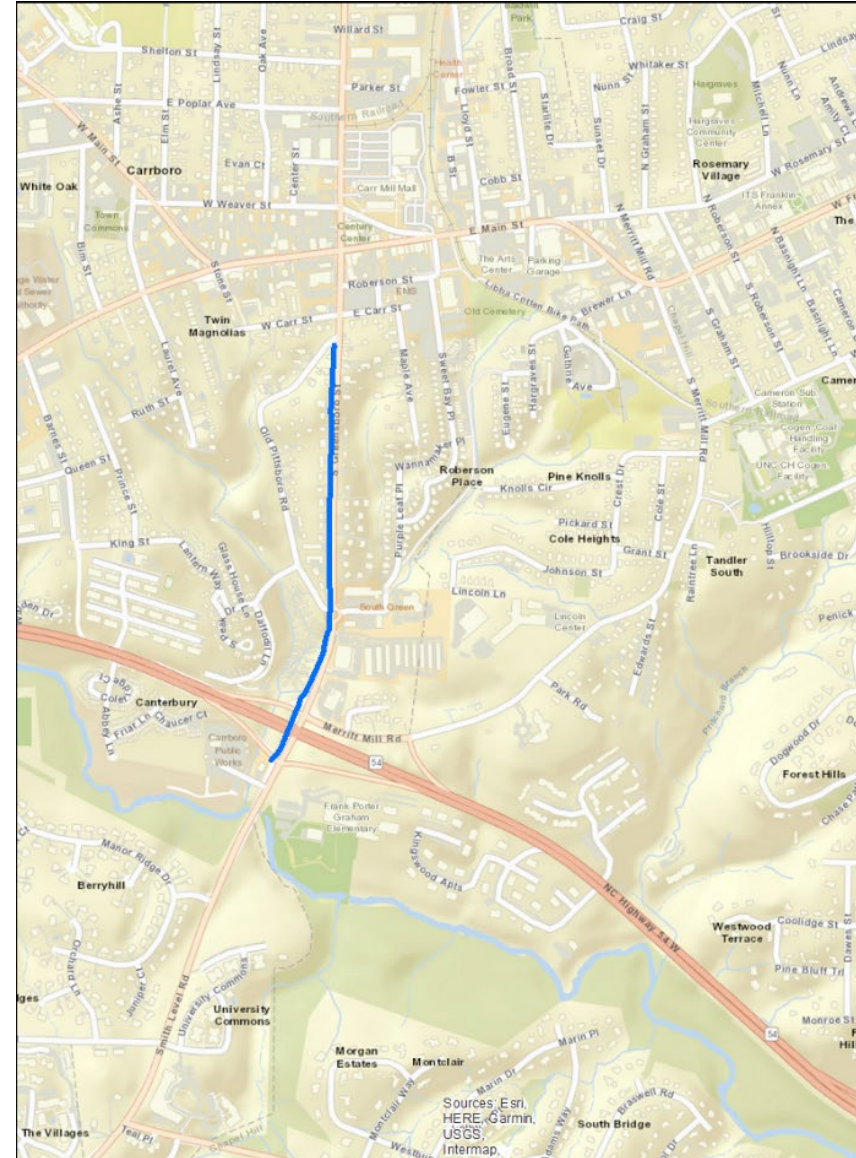
- Federal funding sources:
 - Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ)
 - Surface Transportation Block Program Direct Attributable (STBGDA)
 - Transportation Alternatives Program Direct Attributable (TAPDA)
- Federal funding policy:
 - 25% of STBGDA to transit
 - 50% of STBGDA to local discretionary
 - › To be phased out in FY24
 - 25% of STBGDA, plus CMAQ and TAPDA for Regional Flexible Funding (RFF)
 - › \$3.77M available in FY23
 - › Quantitative scoring rubric, adopted in November 2021

Projects to be Funded

- Existing Projects
 - South Greensboro Street Sidewalk (Carrboro)
 - Fordham Boulevard Sidepath (Chapel Hill)
- Continuing Program
 - TJCOG Transportation Demand Management (TDM)
- New Projects
 - Horton Road Bike/Ped (City of Durham)
 - NC 54/Falconbridge Transit Access (GoTriangle)
 - Morgan Creek Greenway (Chapel Hill)

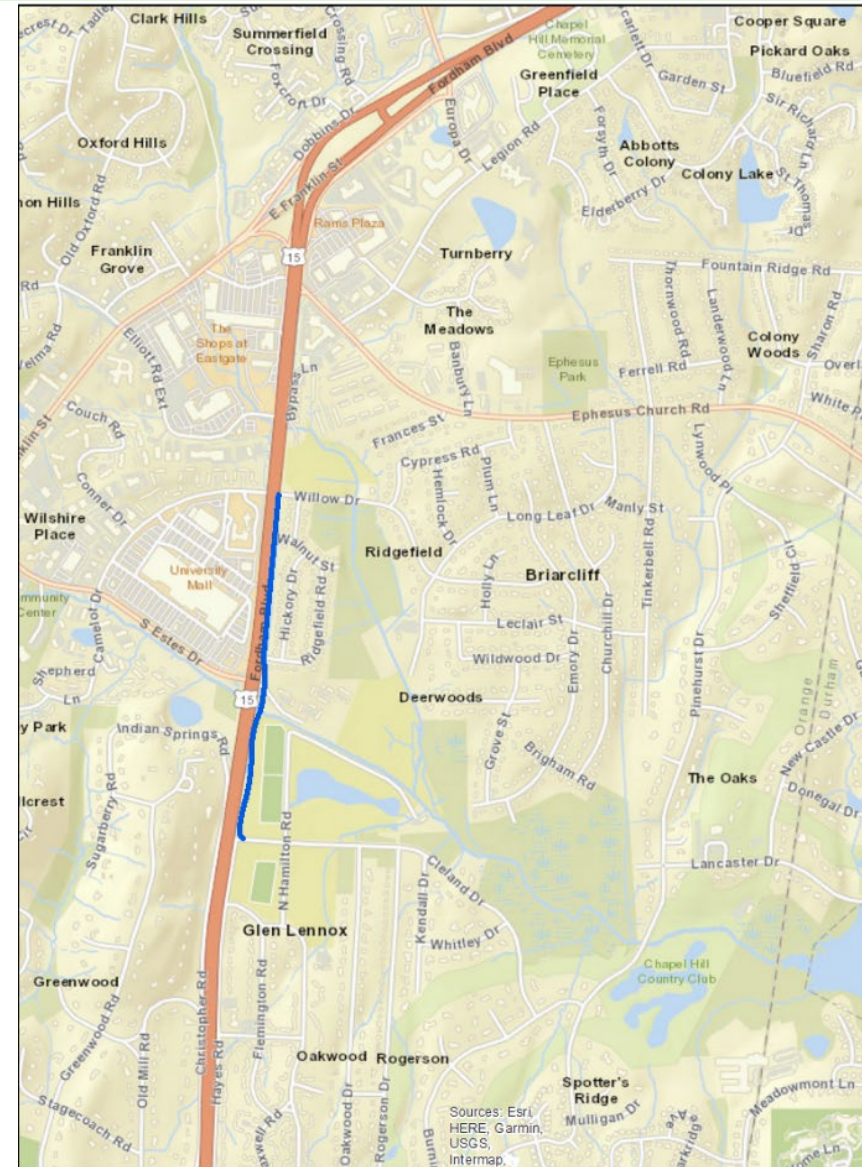
South Greensboro Street Sidewalk

- Construct sidewalk on one side of street
- Received CMAQ funding in 2017
- Design 65% complete; need additional funding to finish project
- Also receiving local discretionary funds



Fordham Boulevard Sidepath

- Construct a sidepath on one side of Fordham Boulevard from Glen Lennox to Willow Drive
- Has previously received TAP and STBGDA
- Needs an additional \$200,000 in federal funds to complete project



- DCHC Federal Funding Policy prioritizes TDM for CMAQ funds
- Combined request with CAMPO
- Continues successful TJCOG program

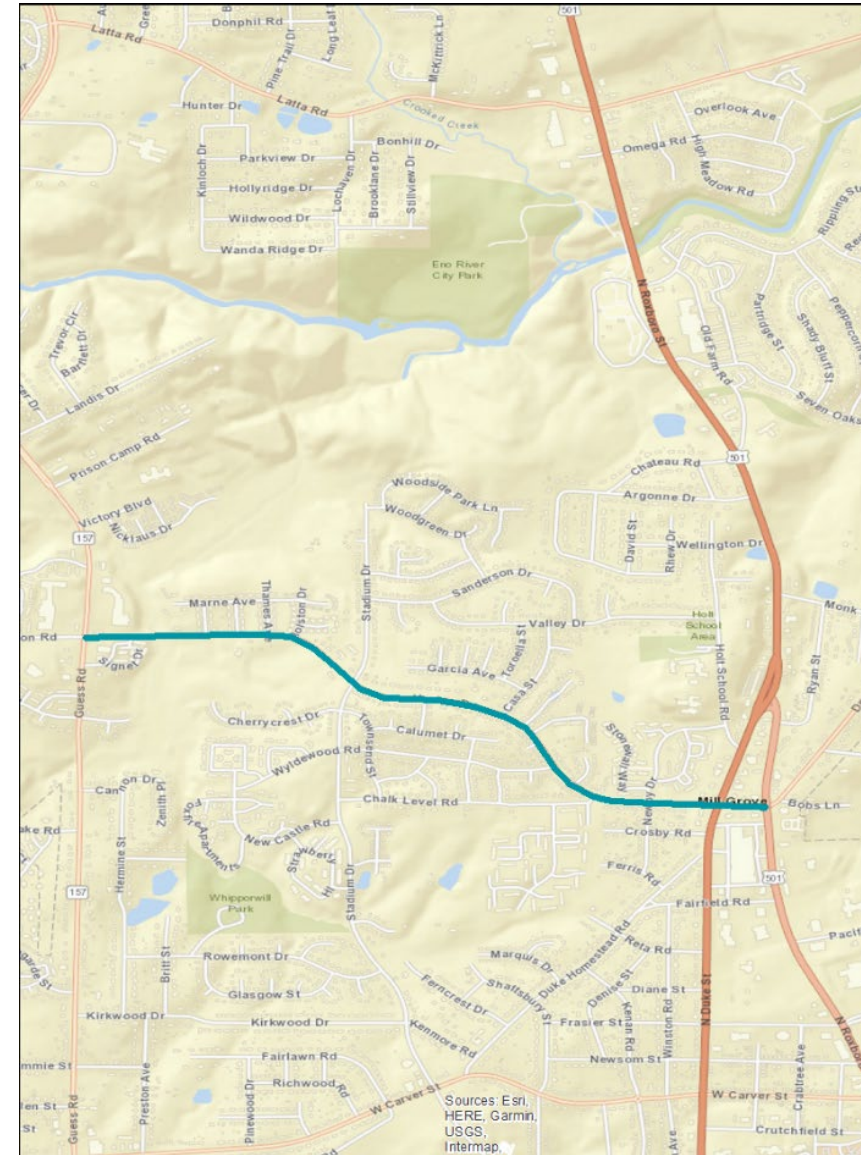

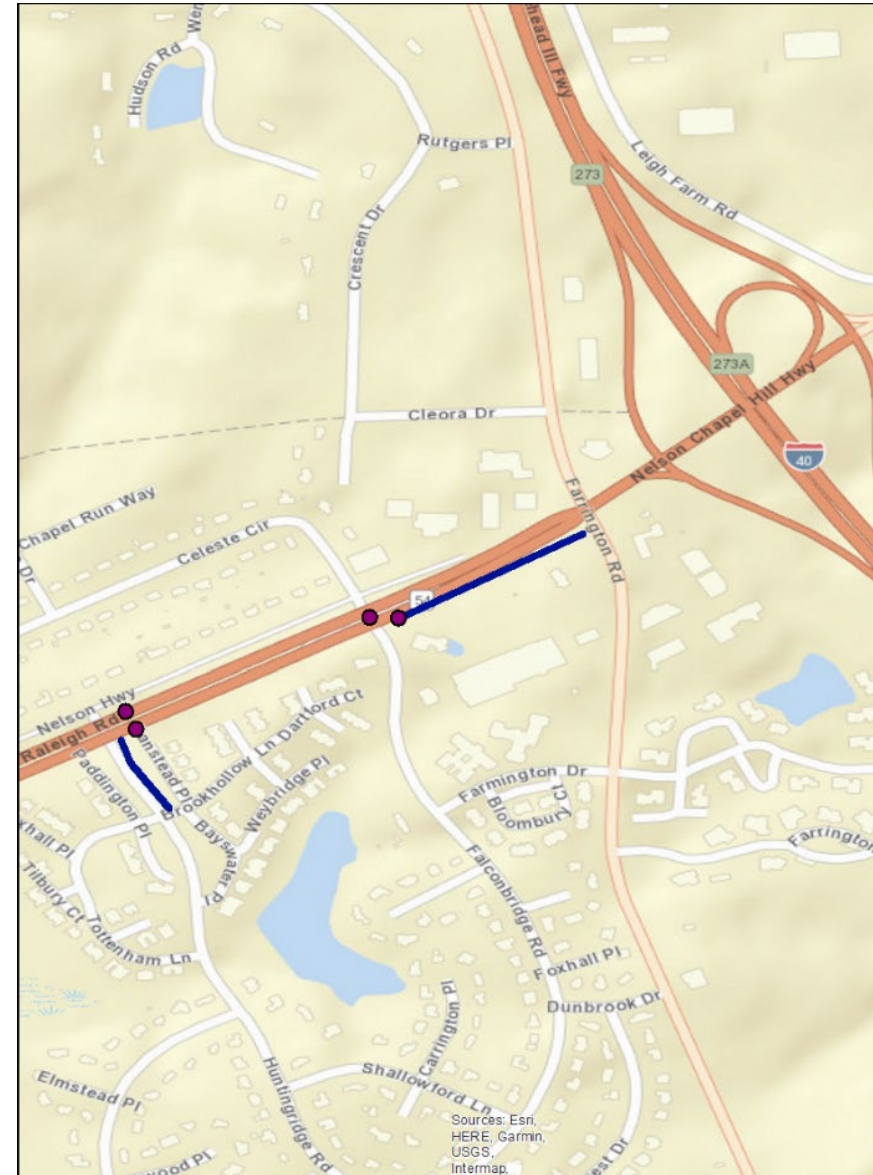
Horton Road Bike/Ped

- Sidepath on south side from Guess to Roxboro
- Sidewalk on north side from Guess to Holston
- Provides safe pedestrian and bike access to commercial areas
- Schedule
 - Design in FY23
 - ROW in FY24
 - Construction in FY25



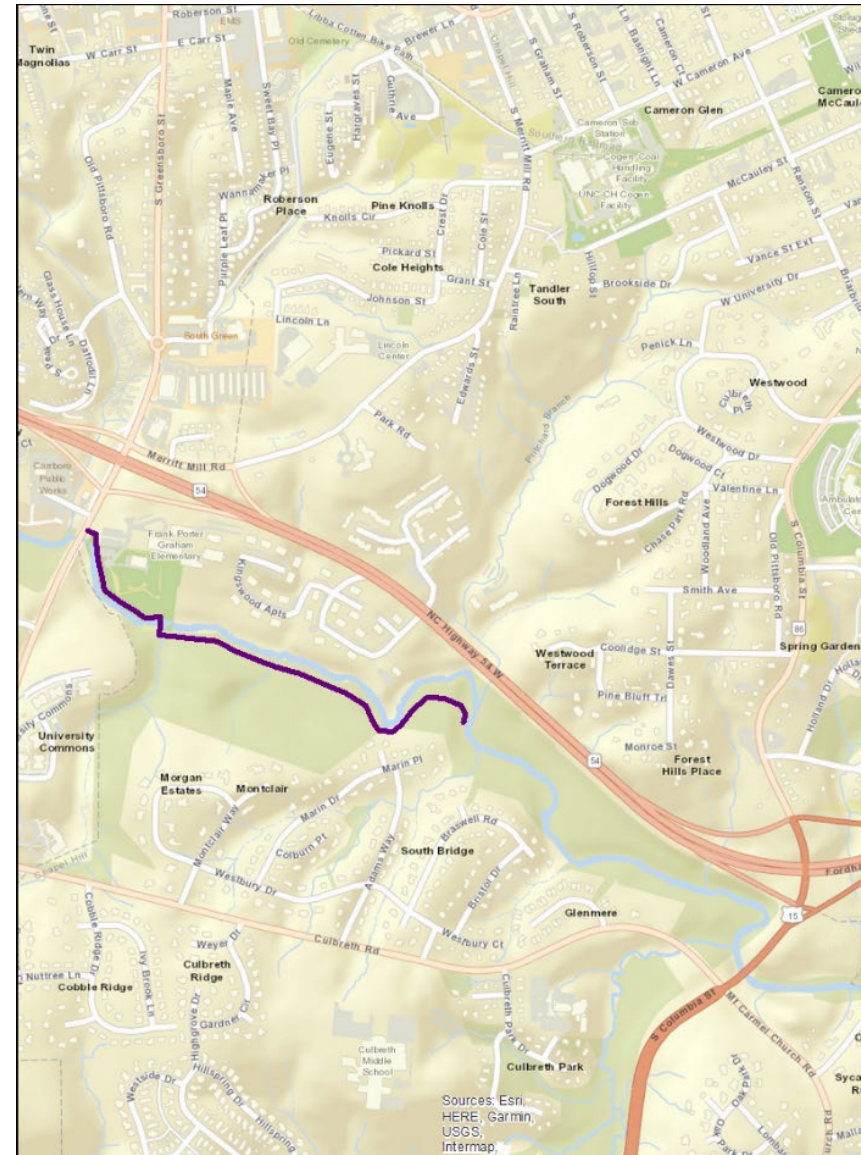
NC 54/Falconbridge Transit Access

- Provide improved safety at bus stops along NC 54 west of I-40
 - Sidewalks
 - Shelters
 - Landing pads
 - Refuge islands
 - Signage
 - Crosswalks (when signalized)
- Construction in FY23
 - Design complete
- Durham Transit Tax Fund supplying local match



Morgan Creek Greenway

- Greenway that will connect to Carrboro path at Smith Level Road
- Provides safe bike/ped alternative to NC 54 Bypass
- Schedule
 - Design complete
 - ROW in FY23
 - Construction in FY23-24
