Subject: Reallocation of Lapsing 5339 Funds for Durham NC UZA

Dear Yvette Taylor,

We have been advised that NCDOT/Orange Public Transit has lapsing 5339 funds from FFY17, FFY18, FFY19, FFY20, and FFY21 for a total of \$95,133. In consultation with the FTA and the four fixed-route transit operators within the DCHC MPO, it has been decided to reallocate Orange Public Transit's lapsing funds to Chapel Hill Transit to utilize these funds. The redistribution of these funds for each FFY and the proposed amended allocations are shown in Table 1 below. Table 2 shows the new total that will be distributed to Chapel Hill Transit.
