8. Revised Amendment #2 to the FY2016-2025 TIP (20 minutes) Lindsay Smart, LPA Staff

During the DCHC MPO Board meeting on February 10, 2016 the Board reviewed draft amendment #2 and released it for the public review and comment period. The DCHC MPO Board held a public hearing for draft amendment #2 on April 13, 2016. The draft amendment has been out for public comment since February 10, 2016. To date, no public comments have been received. The draft amendment has been advertised in the Triangle Tribune and the Herald Sun. The draft amendment has been posted to the DCHC MPO website and circulated via MPO email listservs.

The General Assembly passed the 2016 Appropriations Act (state budget) that limits total State funding for a commuter rail, intercity rail, or light rail project to no more than ten percent (10%) of the estimated total project costs used during the prioritization scoring process. The state budget also makes the Durham-Orange Light Rail Transit (D-O LRT) ineligible for scoring and reprioritization until the Prioritization 5.0 process which will begin in the spring or summer 2018. The previously reviewed draft amendment to the D-O LRT project has been **revised** to respond to the restrictions for light rail included in the recent state budget.

TC Action: Review the revised amendment #2 to the FY2016-2025 TIP and recommend amendment #2 to the Board for approval.

The 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) will be a joint plan by the DCHC MPO and Capital Area MPO (CAMPO) as has been the case for the last two plan updates. The Triangle J Council of Government (TJCOG) has been responsible for coordinating the many activities and tasks of the two MPOs and of local government staff. TJCOG will provide an update on expected methodologies for the socioeconomic data (SE Data), land use modeling (Community Visualization) and the land use scenarios and transportation networks needed for an alternatives analysis, and on assistance that will be needed from local government staff.
