PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT POLICY

- Adopted in 2021
- Guides public involvement efforts by identifying:
 - Planning activities that require public involvement
 - Minimum and advanced notification guidelines
 - How the MPO will respond to public comments
 - Major decision points for plans and studies that require public involvement

ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE REPORT

- Adopted in 2020
- Identifies underrepresented communities (formerly known as "Communities of Concern") and ensures:
 - Fair and full participation
 - Minimize or mitigates disproportionately high and adverse human health or environmental effects
 - the denial, reduction or significant delay in the receipt of benefit



LIMITED ENGLISH PROFICIENCY PLAN

- Adopted in 2021
- The plan provides guidance on:
 - How to identify people who may need language assistance
 - The types of assistance the MPO can provide
 - How to notify people with LEP that language assistance is available

ADA TRANSITION PLAN

- Adopted in September 2017
- The plan ensures access for individuals with disabilities to programs, services and activities that DCHC MPO is responsible for.



TITLE VI NON-DISCRIMINATION PLAN

- Adopted in 2019
- Includes:
 - MPO non-discrimination statement
 - Signed assurance of compliance
 - A designated Title VI liaison and organizational structure
 - Training for MPO employees related to Title VI implementation
 - Complaint procedures, complaint form, and complaint log
