

**RESOLUTION TO ENDORSE APPLICATIONS TO THE NORTH CAROLINA  
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (NCDOT) FOR SAFE ROUTES TO  
SCHOOL PROGRAM FUNDING**

A motion was made by Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro Metropolitan Planning Organization (DCHC MPO) Board Member \_\_\_\_\_ and seconded by DCHC MPO Board Member \_\_\_\_\_ for the approval of the following resolution and upon being put to a vote, was duly adopted.

**WHEREAS**, the N.C. Department of Transportation (NCDOT) has set aside \$1.5 million of Transportation Alternative Program funds for Safe Routes to School programming that can be used by communities to develop creative programs that educate children and parents about safely walking and bicycling to school; and

**WHEREAS**, NCDOT has opened a call for applications to fund collaborative programs that work to reduce the number of bicycle and pedestrian injuries and fatalities, and promote safety through educational programming, encouragement and enforcement; and

**WHEREAS**, in the DCHC MPO region the City of Durham and the Triangle J Council of Governments have prepared and submitted Safe Routes to School funding applications.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro Metropolitan Planning Organization Board hereby endorses the applications submitted by the City of Durham and the Triangle J Council of Governments, provided here on this, the 10th day of April, 2019.
