John Hodges (Retired Commissioner) shared his thoughts on the GoTriangle studies. Regarding the regional rail discussions. Mr. Hodges discussed the rails future and gave his ideas on the need for a Mobility Hub which would include intercity rail, regional rail, regional buses, Wake BRT (and future Durham) BRT and bicycle commuting. John's thoughts were that if a mobility hub were pursued it could cause short- and long-term success.

John Talmadge* reminded the TC Board of the need to for urgency in moving forward with the Safe Streets for All plan and the Vision Zero plan that the MPO received funds in February. Mr. Talmadge brought the attention to the board of the need to not divert our attention to Capital area projects and forget about smaller capital projects. John used the example of the Light Rail Project (which never came to fruition), on which much attention was diverted and leaving little attention to other smaller projects.

Mr. Miller recommended the DCHC MPO Board adopt the resolution that supports the state's pavement and bridge condition and system Performance targets. Damon Seils made a motion to approve the resolution and it was seconded by Nida Allam and the vote passed unanimously.
