73 74	8. FY2024-2033 Draft STIP Swap Kelly Fomenko, LPA Staff		

Kelly Fomenko stated that the MPO's recommendation is to swap in U-6120: NC 98, and to swap out U-6021: Fayetteville, though recently received guidance from NCDOT presented the opportunity to use the remaining funds for additional swaps, such as U-6118: NC 55. Kelly Fomenko stated that the TC must approve the swaps at its January meeting to meet established deadlines.

Brandon Jones said NCDOT recommends additional swaps at the state level: swap out U-5720B: US 70 (Miami Boulevard) Upgrades, and swap in two State rail projects in Wake County (P-5734: Trinity and P-5736: Beryl), and U-5774F: NC 54 Upgrades - Grade Separations at Falconbridge, Farrington, and I-40. Bergen Watterson said Chapel Hill is considering swapping out U-5774B: NC 54 Improvements - Fordham to Barbee Chapel. Chair Ellen Beckmann recommended to defer a vote until January, and requested local staff provide information to the MPO for the January agenda.

9. FY2024 Draft Unified Planning Work Program

David Miller, LPA Staff

David Miller stated that due to ongoing discussions with member jurisdictions about FY24 UPWP submissions, an amendment to the FY24 UPWP development schedule was recommended. David Miller said that the amended schedule would delay the draft FY24 UPWP presentation until the January 25, 2023 TC meeting.

Vice Chair Nishith Trivedi made a motion to recommend that the MPO Board approve the FY24 UPWP development schedule amendment. Margaret Hauth seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

8. Targets for Safety Performance Measures

97 Andy Henry, LPA Staff

Andy Henry shared the targets for safety performance measures from 2018 to 2022, the proposed safety targets for 2023, and stated that adopting the safety targets are required by federal legislation. Andy Henry said that the MPO has the option to establish its own safety

101 targets or adopt the safety targets developed by NCDOT, and added that the MPO has 102 supported the safety targets NCDOT has developed. Tom Devlin made a motion to recommend that the DCHC MPO Board adopt the 103 resolution that supports the state's safety targets. Vice Chair Nishith Trivedi seconded the 104 105 motion. The motion passed unanimously. 11. DCHC MPO Technical Committee Officer Election 106 Doug Plachcinski, AICP, CFM, DCHC MPO Executive Director 107 Doug Plachcinski stated that the MPO has received TC Officer nominations for Nishith 108 Trivedi as Chair, and Ellen Beckmann as Vice Chair. Doug Plachcinski stated that additional 109 nominations are due by January 11, 2023, and the election will occur at the January 25 TC 110 111 meeting. 112 **REPORTS FROM STAFF:** 12. Report from Staff 113 Doug Plachcinski, Executive Director, DCHC MPO 114 Doug Plachcinski had no information to add to his written report. Dale McKeel shared 115 that Triangle J Council of Governments (TJCOG) has released its request for proposals for the 116 Triangle Transportation Choices transportation demand management (TDM) grant program. 117 118 13. Report from the Technical Committee Chair Ellen Beckmann, TC Chair 119 120 Chair Ellen Beckmann stated that the Durham Transit Plan process is near completion. 14. NCDOT Reports 121 122 Brandon Jones (David Keilson), Division 5 – NCDOT Brandon Jones had no additional report. 123 Wright Archer (Pat Wilson, Stephen Robinson), Division 7 - NCDOT 124 Stephen Robinson said that the New Hope Church Road Bridge Replacement project is 125 126 slated to be completed by January, and added that the I-40 widening project requires additional modifications that are being addressed. 127

128 Patrick Norman (Bryan Kluchar), Division 8 - NCDOT 129 Bryan Kluchar had no additional report. Julie Bogle, Transportation Planning Division – NCDOT 130 Scott Walston said that NCDOT's consultants have finished the draft Freight Plan, which 131 132 is expected to be released for review soon. Scott Walston said that outreach pertaining to the electric vehicle component of the NC Clean Transportation Plan is expected. Scott Walston 133 shared that a presentation for the Carbon Reduction Plan is available to MPOs. 134 John Grant, Traffic Operations – NCDOT 135 There was no additional report. 136 Nick Morrison, Integrated Mobility Division – NCDOT 137 Nick Morrison shared that applications for the Safe Routes to School program and the 138 139 Paved Trails and Sidewalk Feasibility Grant program are being accepted and includes 100% 140 program funding. Adjourn 141 There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned by Chair Ellen Beckmann 142
