What is the FY23 Transit Work Program?



- Allocates funds collected for transit tax and fees
- Identifies projects that will receive funds
- July 1, 2022 June 30, 2023 (Fiscal Year 2023)
- Administered by DCHC MPO and GoTriangle

What Transit Improvements Are Already Being Implemented?



Continued Service Expansion

- GoTriangle routes 400, 405, 700, 800, DRX, ODX
- GoDurham routes 1, 2, 4, 5, 8, 10, 12
- Chapel Hill Transit routes A, CM, D, F, HS, J and NS
- Hillsborough Circulator
- GoDurham Connect

Bus Stop Improvements

- At least 75 stops to be constructed in FY23; increased funding
- North-South BRT
- Hillsborough Train Station
- Transit Emphasis Corridor (TEC) Design

What are the Proposed New FY23 Projects in Durham?



- Northern Durham Improvements
 - GoDurham Routes 9A & 9B
 - New Crosstown Service
- Headway reduction on GoDurham Route 3
- New paratransit maintenance facility
- Improvements to current GoTriangle Bus Operations and Maintenance Facility (BOMF)
- Durham Station Improvements
- Sidewalk construction at NC 98 and Mineral Springs Road
- City of Durham Implementation Staff

What Are the New Proposed Projects in Orange?



- Additional service on the Chapel Hill Transit CW Route
- Design for new regional transit facility (Orange share)

Material Changes to the Durham Transit Plan



- Interlocal Agreement (ILA) requires material changes be adopted by all three governing boards
 - Durham BOCC
 - GoTriangle Board of Trustees
 - DCHC MPO Board
- Four projects either meet ILA material change requirements or were requested by Staff Working Group (SWG)
 - Northern Durham Improvements
 - New paratransit maintenance facility
 - Durham Station Improvements
 - Durham Bus Stop Improvements
- No proposed material changes to the Orange Transit Plan
