

What is the UPWP?





- Required by federal regulation
- Details and guides transportation planning activities
- Annual funding document
- Funding comes from FHWA and FTA and is matched by state and local sources
 - FHWA provides 80% and requires a 20% local match
 - FTA provides 80% transit funding, NCDOT provides 10% for 5303, and transit agencies provide 10% match
 - In 2014, the MPO began cost sharing for the FHWA 20% local match

- Funding Source: Safe & Accessible Transportation Options – Metro Planning (Y-410) – Distributed to MPO's to increase safe and accessible options for multiple travel modes for people of all ages and abilities.

FHWA Funding:

- STBG-DA: Section 133(b)(3)(7)
 - Flexible funding that can be used for projects to preserve and improve conditions and performance of public roads, pedestrian and bike infrastructure, and to implement transit capital projects
- Planning (PL): Section 104(f)
 - Distributed by population to MPO's to conduct planning activities
- Safe & Accessible Transportation
 Options (Y-410):
 - Distributed to MPO's to increase safe and accessible options for multiple travel modes for people of all ages and abilities.

FY2024 UPWP Development Schedule



Dates	DCHC MPO Activity Description
October -December 2022	Development of draft FY2024 UPWP in coordination with local agencies.
January 25, 2023	TC reviews draft FY2024 UPWP and recommends Board release for public comment.
February 8, 2023	MPO Board reviews draft of FY2024 UPWP and releases draft for public comment.
March 8, 2023	MPO Board holds public hearing
March 22, 2023	TC receives final FY2024 UPWP and recommends Board approve final at March Board meeting.
April 12, 2023	MPO Board approves final FY2024 UPWP, including approval of self-certification process and local match.
April 12, 2023	Deadline for final FY2024 UPWP to be submitted to NCDOT and FHWA for approval. NCDOT/PTD will submit UPWP to FTA for approval.



- TC Recommendation (January 25, 2023)
 - Recommend the Board release the Draft FY2024 UPWP for public comment.

- Board Action (February 8, 2023)
 - Review the Draft FY2024 UPWP and authorize release for public comment.
