5. <u>2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) -- Deficiency Analysis (20</u> <u>minutes)</u>

The Deficiency Analysis is the next step in the 2045 MTP development process. It uses region, corridor and roadway level analysis to identify future transportation deficiencies. Staff will present the Deficiency Analysis to the Technical Committee and ask that it be forwarded to the MPO Board for review and to be released for public comment. The MPO has an interest in expediting the MTP development because approval after February 2017 would impose new, unfamiliar plan requirements, and an approval after April 2017 would mean a plan lapse (i.e., no new federal transportation actions in the MPO area). When available, the Deficiency Analysis will be posted to the Deficiencies tab on the following MPO Web page: www.bit.ly/DCHC-MTP. The Community Plan land use scenario, on which the Deficiency Analysis is based, is already available on the Land Use tab of that Web site.

The tentative schedule for the 2045 MTP is as a follows:

- * Deficiency Analysis; Board release in June
- * Alternatives Analysis, Board release in August
- * Locally Preferred Alternative (LPA), Board release in October
- * Adopted 2045 MTP, Board adopt in December.

TC Action: Review, provide comments, and forward to Board for release.

SPOT 5.0 Update (15 minutes)

DCHC MPO staff will provide an update on the status of DCHC projects to be submitted for SPOT 5.0 this summer, as well as discuss the process going forward. The projects submitted to MPO staff for consideration for submittal for SPOT 5.0 are attached.

The following changes have occurred to the list of carryover projects to be modified that was approved at the last MPO Board meeting:

- U-5720C - Based on discussions with NCDOT staff, extending this project to the limits of U-5518B (Aviation Parkway Extension) can be done through a modification of the project should U-5518B get funded in the FY2018-27 TIP; no modification needs to be made at this time.

- R-5821 - Inclusion of a superstreet design at NC 54 and Old Fayetteville Road will be incorporated into H140374-E, thereby not requiring R-5821 to be rescored.

- The Chapel Hill Town Council will review projects for possible modification at its May 22, 2017 meeting. Those projects will be brought to the TC on May 24.

- The deadline for submission of modifications and deletions has been pushed back by the SPOT office until at least June 30, 2017.

TC Action: Forward the list of proposed projects to the MPO Board for its consideration.

7. <u>STBGDA Projects through FFY18 (10 minutes)</u> Aaron Cain, LPA Staff

On February 22, 2017, the DCHC MPO released a call for projects for unprogrammed prior year and upcoming FFY18 STBGDA funds distributed to local governments through the MPO. The attached document details the requests provided by local government staff. These requests will be approved by the DCHC MPO Board as part of the TIP approval process, scheduled for final adoption on August 9, 2017.

If approved, all funds will be distributed as part of the development of the FY2018-27 TIP, and will be available October 1, 2017, except the following:

- Chatham County and Orange County funds will be flexed to transit and will follow the necessary procedure, and

- Funds directed to C-5572, West Ellerbe Creek Trail, are FY17 funds, and a TIP amendment requesting their use as part of the FY2016-25 STIP is under consideration. If approved, those funds will be available this June.

Amendment #10 for the FY2016-25 Transportation Improvement Plan includes one request from the City of Durham to program \$383,670 of FY17 STBGDA funds (\$380,081 from the City of Durham, \$3,589 from Durham County) to project C-5572, West Ellerbe Creek Trail. This request is being made so that funds can be accessed more readily for a project that is ready for construction. A summary list and full report of the changes are included as attachments along with a resolution to be signed by the MPO Board Chair upon approval by the Board.
