5. <u>CMAQ Funding Recommendation (20 minutes)</u>

DCHC MPO receives a biennial allocation of Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement (CMAQ) funds from NCDOT for disbursement within member jurisdictions and agencies. CMAQ funds are federal funds that are to be directed to projects that show an air quality benefit upon implementation. A 20 percent local match is required for CMAQ funds. DCHC MPO received \$2,194,011 in CMAQ funding for FY22.

Eight CMAQ applications were submitted by local jurisdictions and agencies for this funding cycle. The total requested funding from these eight applications is \$5,790,001. LPA staff reviewed applications and performed an analysis primarily based on federally required emissions criteria to recommend which projects should be funded to the TC.

Once the MPO Board approves a list of recommended projects for CMAQ funding, LPA staff will forward those recommended projects to NCDOT for review. NCDOT makes the final determination on whether or not to grant the funding requests.

TC Action: Recommend Board approval of list of recommended projects for CMAQ funding as proposed by LPA staff.

Board Action: Approve the resolution authorizing submission of the recommended CMAQ projects to NCDOT.

The DCHC MPO adopted the Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP) in May 2017. Chair Nishith Trivedi called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m. Aaron Cain noted that the roll call could be completed by utilizing the zoom participant list. Aaron Cain introduced the new MPO intern, Kayla Mathews.

PRELIMINARIES:

Adjustments to the Agenda

Chair Nishith Trivedi asked if there were any adjustments to the agenda. Aaron Cain noted two items, the first was safety performance measures and the second was to make everyone aware of the Call for Projects that was released January 26, 2021. These items would be added to the end of the agenda.

Public Comments

Chair Nishith Trivedi asked if there were any requests for public comment. There were no public comments.

CONSENT AGENDA:

The January 6, 2021 meeting minutes will be presented at the February TC meeting.

ACTION ITEMS:

4. US 15-501 Corridor Study (10 minutes) Andy Henry, LPA staff

Chair Nishith Trivedi mentioned that this section was intended to discuss comments and would not need a vote. Andy Henry reminded the committee that at the January meeting, the MPO Board asked staff to make a few changes to the scope, including adding a third stakeholder group and ensuring the study is aspirational. Andy Henry said the scope will be revised and brought back to the TC in February before going to the MPO Board in March. Jay Heikes noted the need to coordinate with ongoing transit plan updates both in Orange and Durham Counties as well as other potential follow up studies. Andy Henry said he would go ahead and add that to the public engagement part of the scope. Andy Henry mentioned if anyone thinks of comments later, they would be welcome at any time.

This item was for discussion purposes, no further action was required by the TC.

<u>5. FY2022 Unified Planning Work Program (15 minutes)</u> Felix Nwoko, LPA Staff

Felix Nwoko informed the group that the Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) was released by the Board for public comments, and so far none have been received. Felix Nwoko mentioned a few new changes to the FY 22 UPWP New Initiatives, stating that the cost was removed that was associated with some initiatives as they would be completed by MPO staff and the two new low-cost initiatives requested by TJCOG. Felix Nwoko added that another change was that the FY 22 Planning (PL) funds estimate has been added to the funding for new initiatives, and an equivalent amount of Surface

Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funds has been removed so there is no net change to overall funding for new initiatives.

Chair Nishith Trivedi asked for confirmation that the MPO will pay the local match for the two US-70 studies and Felix Nwoko confirmed this. Zach Hallock asked about the third item on the New Initiative table attachment after much local interest in an emission estimation tool. Felix Nwoko answered that there will be some minor formatting changes to the document. Julie Bogle and Felix Nwoko discussed coordination with the State Transportation Involvement Program (STIP) on the unobligated STBG funds.

Kumar Neppalli made a motion to recommend that the MPO Board approve the UPWP.

Zach Hallock seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

6. Draft Public Involvement Policy (PIP) and Limited English Proficiency Plan (LEP) (20 minutes) Anne Phillips, LPA Staff

Anne Phillips shared that the MPO has advertised the public comment period, but so far none have been received. The TC previously requested an executive summary and examples of the spectrum of engagement which have since been added to the PIP. There was a public hearing at the last MPO Board meeting, but nobody spoke at that hearing. Pierre Owusu asked if the MPO was a part of the City of Durham LEP group. Anne Phillips replied that the MPO is not part of that group, but the required federal procedures are very similar. In response to a question from Pierre Owsusu, Anne Phillips clarified that the MPO does not have a budget associated with the LEP, so moving forward the MPO should keep track of expenses related to implementation of the LEP.

Chance Mullis made a motion to recommend that the MPO Board approve the PIP and LEP Plan. Pierre Owusu seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

7. CTP Amendment #3 (15 minutes) Andy Henry, LPA Staff

Andy Henry gave a presentation on the Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP)

Amendment #3 and asked for any comments. The presentation covered the CTP and

Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) relationship, previous CTP amendments, summarized the proposed CTP Amendment #3, and reviewed the proposed schedule. Zach

Hallock mentioned it would be helpful to identify what municipalities have regarding local Bicycle and Pedestrian plans and that Carrboro adopted their new Bicycle and Pedestrian plan on January 12, 2021.

John Hodges-Copple stated that the language in the CTP should not be constraining. Vice Chair Ellen Beckmann mentioned there would be a lot of overlap in the engagement process in terms of what the MPO is asking for the CTP Amendment #3 and the Orange and Durham Counties MTPs. Aaron Cain mentioned that these efforts could be coordinated. Andy Henry stated the need for greater clarification to avoid public confusion as the MTPs are smaller, more well defined plans whereas the CTPs are much broader.

Jay Heikes asked Andy Henry about how much thought has gone towards bus stops and bus pull outs that are elements of the Complete Streets policy. Andy Henry said bus stops and bus pull outs haven't been designated yet in the CTP, but the language of the complete streets policy will be added that encompasses many elements. Andy Henry stated he would add slides to address today's discussion before forwarding the presentation to the MPO Board.

This item was for discussion purposes only, no action was required by the TC.

8. FFY 2021 CRRSSA (COVID Relief) Section 5307 Apportionment for DCHC UZA (5 minutes)

Felix Nwoko, LPA Staff

Felix Nwoko reviewed the CARES ACT 5307 Split Letter that divides the funding in a manner that is consistent with methodologies formerly approved by the MPO Board. Jomar Pastorelle asked about the reason for safety and security funds.

Felix Nwoko responded that transit agencies are required to set aside 1% of their funding for safety and security measures. Meg Scully added that transit agencies generally meet the safety and security minimum requirement with other funding which is why it does not appear on the attached apportionment chart.

Jomar Pastorelle made a motion to recommend that the MPO Board approved the Section 5307 Apportionment split letter for COVID relief. Pierre Owusu seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

9. FHWA Highway Infrastructure Funding Swap (10 minutes) Anne Phillips, LPA Staff

Anne Phillips mentioned the MPO did this funding swap last year and it is a fairly routine action. Anne Phillips explained that the MPO has received its allocation of Highway Infrastructure (Infra) funds from NCDOT, but these funds can only be used for projects with a vehicular benefit. Additionally, NCDOT has offered to swap Infra funds for STBG funds, which can be used for projects more in line with the MPO's goals.

Evan Tenenbaum made a motion to recommend Board approval of the FHWA Highway Infrastructure funding swap with NCDOT. Jomar Pastorelle seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

10. Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment #4 (5 minutes) Anne Phillips, LPA Staff

Anne Phillips explained that the changes in this amendment were mostly changes made to the STIP by NCDOT and therefore needed to be reflected in DCHC MPO's TIP. Anne Phillips asked attendees to review projects in their jurisdictions to see if there are any potentially conflicting changes. Evan Tenenbaum asked if project funding amounts that have been previously discussed are included in this amendment or if they would be included in a subsequent amendment. Anne Phillips answered that there are mostly schedule changes in TIP Amendment #4 and Aaron Cain added that some funding changes, such as to Morreene Road, are included in this amendment. Aaron Cain stated there may be another TIP Amendment from the MPO to ensure NCDOT is clear about how much funding should be allocated to each project for the STIP.

Kumar Neppalli made a motion to recommend the Board approve TIP Amendment #4.

Scott Whiteman seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

10A. Safety Performance Measures Andy Henry, LPA Staff

Andy Henry stated the goal for this agenda item is to elicit comments and forward the item to the MPO Board for adoption by resolution. Andy Henry gave a presentation on the Transportation Performance Measures – Safety (TPMS) that are a federal requirement. In January 2019, the MPO adopted Safety measures and targets that were subsequently updated in November 2019. The MPO has two options – to either establish their own measures or to support NCDOT measure values. There was a discussion on the benefits and drawbacks of each option and a consensus was reached to support NCDOT measures so as to gain access to NCDOT data and to not incur additional burden on MPO staff.

Felix Nwoko stated that because the MPO Board has expressed interest in an MPOcentric safety TPMS plan, a compromise may be necessary to follow NCDOT targets while the MPO develops a broader plan that discusses objectives and strategies. Joe Geigle added that no MPO within NC has adopted their own performance targets. Andy Henry added that funding and decision making processes would be unlikely to change if the MPO created their own performance targets despite the significant burden of staff time required to gather data and calculate targets. Vice Chair Ellen Beckmann and Joe Geigle discussed whether NCDOT and DCHC MPO had compatible safety goals. Chair Nishith Trivedi added that NCDOT approved a Highway Strategic Safety Plan in 2019 that identifies how they plan to achieve their targets. Joe Geigle clarified that the 2035 reduction by 50% is an interim goal to bridge the gap to the 2050 goal of zero fatalities or serious injuries (Vision Zero).

Kumar Neppalli made a motion to recommend that the MPO Board endorse NCDOT safety targets by resolution. Pierre Owusu seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

10B. Call for Projects Anne Phillips, LPA Staff

Anne Phillips mentioned the MPO sent out the call for projects on January 26, 2021, including application materials for STBG and Congestion Mitigation Air Quality Improvement (CMAQ) funds. Applications are due on February 10, 2021. Aaron Cain reminded everyone that all of these funding sources require a 20% local match. Ellen Beckmann asked if the STBG any area funds are divided by jurisdiction. Aaron Cain responded that those funds are available to any jurisdiction through a competitive application basis.

Aaron Cain added that, as discussed previously with MPO staff after they were notified by localities of potential funding shortfalls on existing projects, along with the backlog of projects, the funds will be preferentially given to existing projects to finish the implementation process rather than adding new projects to the list of uncompleted projects.

11. TC Officer Elections (10 minutes) 21-113 Aaron Cain, LPA Staff

Aaron Cain stated per the bylaws that a new Chair and Vice Chair need to be elected.

The only nominations that have been received thus far is Ellen Beckmann for Chair and Nishith

Trivedi for Vice Chair. Aaron Cain opened up the virtual floor for any other nominations before proceeding.

Pierre Owusu made a motion to approve the nominations of Ellen Beckmann for Chair and Nishith Trivedi for Vice Chair. Jomar Pastorelle seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

At this point in the meeting, Ellen Beckmann officially became the Chair of the TC and Nishith Trivedi became the Vice Chair.

REPORTS FROM STAFF:

12. Report from Staff Felix Nwoko, LPA Staff

Felix Nwoko brought up that the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) released the new Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSA) that has been published in the Federal Registrar for a 60 day comment period. The OMB is proposing raising the minimum threshold for an MSA from the current threshold of 50,000 people to the proposed threshold of 100,000 people. It is unclear how this new change would affect the MPO's mission or the MPO as a whole.

11. Report from the Chair

Chair Ellen Beckmann had no additional report.

12. NCDOT Reports

Joey Hopkins (David Keilson, Richard Hancock), Division 5 - NCDOT

David Keilson reported comments on two projects. The Alston Avenue project and the reopening of the Alston/Holloway intersection has been pushed back a month due to weather

and utility conflicts. The Old Durham/Old Chapel Hill Road project the water line that was slowing the project down is being pressure tested today and if it passes, then the remaining sidewalk, curb, and final inch of asphalt can be completed ideally before the Wegmans Store opens on February 24, 2021.

Introduction

The Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro (DCHC) MPO invites member jurisdictions and agencies to submit funding applications for Congestion Mitigation Air Quality Improvement (CMAQ), Surface Transportation Block Grant - Direct Attributable (STBGDA), Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG), and Regional Bicycle and Pedestrian (STBGDA and Transportation Alternative Program - Direct Attributable or TAPDA) projects.

The application and selection process is guided by the attached Policy Framework for DCHC MPO Federal Funds. **All applications are due on February 10, 2021 by 5 p.m.**

A few things to keep in mind:

- Applicants are also encouraged to seek funding for existing projects to improve project delivery.
- Applicants are encouraged to submit bicycle, pedestrian, and transit projects to support the growth of a multimodal transportation network in our region.
- All funding sources require a 20% local match.
- Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) projects must come from an adopted ITS Plan.

CMAQ

Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement (CMAQ) funds are available for transportation projects and programs that improve air quality by increasing the efficiency of existing transportation facilities or reducing travel demand on those facilities. General purpose roadway projects are not eligible. The minimum amount that can be requested is \$100,000 per DCHC policy.

Funding Available: \$2,194,011

<u>Funding Note</u>: CMAQ funds are usually used to support the regional Transportation Demand Management (TDM) program. TJCOG has requested \$571,487 to support the program, which leaves **\$1,622,514** available for programing.

Application Procedure: CMAQ Application form (attached)

Other Notes:

- The MPO will perform emissions calculations for all CMAQ project submittals and use the results to prioritize projects for funding.

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STBGDA

Surface Transportation Block Grants – Direct Attributable provide flexible funding that communities can use to improve or construct roadways, bridges, bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure, and to implement transit capital projects. This call is for all available funding through FY22.

Other notes:

- The City of Durham and Durham County do not have any funds available. In 2019, the City of Durham programmed the entirety of their STBGDA distribution through FY24 for bike/ped projects. Durham County uses its funds for a county planning position.
- Due to delays in implementation of previously programmed projects, priority will be given to use of funds to further implementation of existing projects, rather than the creation of new projects.

STBG (Any Area)

These STBG funds are available to any jurisdiction in the DCHC area, and were obtained by DCHC through a fund swap with NCDOT. Surface Transportation Block Grants provide flexible funding that communities can use to improve or construct roadways, bridges, bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure, and to implement transit capital projects. These funds are available for use in FY21.

Funding Available: \$752,885

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<u>Funding Note</u>: The total available amount of \$752,885 is contingent on the MPO Board's approval of a swap of \$338,079 of Highway Infrastructure Funds for STBG funds at the February 10, 2021, MPO Board meeting.

Other Notes:

• Due to delays in implementation of previously programmed projects, priority will be given to use of funds to further implementation of existing projects, rather than the creation of new projects.

Regional Bicycle and Pedestrian Projects (STBGDA and TAPDA)

Projects in this category will span multiple jurisdictions or otherwise provide regional benefits through increased connectivity. Per MPO Policy, Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) funds are combined with a set aside of STBGDA funds for our Regional Bike-Ped program.

TAP funds may only be used for transportation alternatives including bicycle and pedestrian facilities, trails, scenic areas, community improvement activities, environmental mitigation, and safe routes to school programs. No roadway capacity improvement projects are eligible for TAP funds.

Funding Available: \$1,812,318 (FY21 & FY22 combined)

Application Procedure: Address the screening and scoring criteria below in a two-page memo. Include a map of the project site as an attachment to the memo.

Screening Criteria

- Projects must request a minimum of \$1,000,000 federal funding.
- Only the next imminent project phase should be requested (i.e. construction funding should only be requested once design and right-of-way are complete).
- Projects must be part of the adopted bicycle and pedestrian Regional Routes as listed in the current Metropolitan Transportation Plan. For a list of regional routes, see Appendix 4 of the 2045 MTP.

Scoring Criteria

- 40% Project readiness priority will be given to projects that are ready to be constructed or are ready to move to the next phase of project development:
 - o 100 points Construction funding requested right-of-way and design complete
 - o 50 points Right-of-way funding requested design complete
 - o 25 points Planning requested

30% Safety

 Variable score from 0-100 points based on the relative number of bike/ped crashes on the facility or parallel facility.

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15% Spans multiple jurisdictions

- 100 points spans more than two local jurisdictions
- o 50 points spans more than one local jurisdiction

15% Density

 Variable score from 0-100 points based on the relative population and employment density of a 0.5 mile buffer of the corridor.

Other Notes:

- The MPO has broadly defined "regional" in the past. Examples of projects that would qualify as regional include the Hillsborough Riverwalk and those related to the American Tobacco Trail as they are part of a statewide or national trail system. In addition, projects shown in the 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) qualify for this funding.





US 15-501 Corridor Study

Scope – Summary (version: January 19, 2021)

This scope summarizes the tasks and products needed to finish the US 15-501 Corridor Study. Staff will use this summarized scope to create a request for proposal to select a consultant known for their creative bicycle, pedestrian and transit planning solutions. The request for proposal will emphasize that the DCHC MPO seeks solutions for the US 15-501 Corridor that are truly aspirational and lead the travel of our future rather than react to it.

Review Draft Corridor Study and Process

The consultant will become familiar with the draft US 15-501 Corridor Study report, including the vision and goals, demographic and travel profiles, public participation process, alternatives, recommendations and implementation, and the conceptual design. It is important that the consultant understand how the Study's proposed transportation system for the Chapel Hill segment and the I-40/US 15-501 quadrant area did not meet the newly adopted Goals and Objectives of the DCHC MPO and the interests of several people who provided comments to the Board. The proposed design of the Chapel Hill segment favored vehicle travel over that of bicyclists and pedestrians, and included an 8-lane cross-section and Reduced Conflict Intersection (RCI) that would make bicycle and pedestrian crossing hazardous. The sole interchange proposed for the I-40/US 15-501 quadrant was viewed as providing inadequate access to the Patterson Place and New Hope Commons developments, and as making bicycle and pedestrian movement hazardous between the developments.

The consultant will review segment 1 (i.e., Chapel Hill) and the I-40/US 15-501 quadrant area because these two areas need further public input, technical analysis, and development to create a Corridor Study that can be adopted. Segments 2, 3, and 4 will also require review and further development, but the level of effort in these segments is not expected to be as high as segment 1 and the I-40/US 15-501 quadrant area.

The consultant will conduct an informational meeting with the Project Steering Committee to identify and understand the unresolved issues in the draft Corridor Study report, conceptual design, and process. The Project Steering Committee is composed of staff from the DCHC MPO, Town of Chapel Hill, City of Durham, Durham County, GoTriangle, GoDurham, and NCDOT who were involved in the US 15-501 Corridor Study.

Product

DCHC MPO will produce: A compilation of the comments received on the draft
 US 15-501 Corridor Study and staff responses to the comments, which identifies



the unresolved issues. The draft report, summary report, and conceptual design in original software format; and, any demographic or travel data (e.g., counts and crashes) requested by the consultant

Conduct Issues Meeting with Stakeholders

The consultant will conduct one meeting with three different stakeholder groups to identify and understand the issues that stakeholders have with the draft Corridor Study. The stakeholder groups will be: segment 1 (i.e., Chapel Hill segment); I-40/US 15-501 quadrant area; and, segments 2, 3 and 4. There are three stakeholder groups because the issues and membership of each group is expected to be fairly distinct. If needed, the meetings will be virtual (i.e., online). The consultant will prepare any materials for the meeting, design the meeting format, and conduct the meeting. DCHC MPO staff will provide administration and coordination, including: identify and notify potential stakeholders; prepare the attendee list for each stakeholder group; and, obtain the meeting site if there is an in-person meeting.

<u>Product</u>

- <u>Consultant will produce</u>: Summary of issues in draft US 15-501 Corridor Study for each stakeholder group that might include maps and conceptual designs
- <u>DCHC MPO will produce</u>: Attendee list, meeting site, Web site and social media support

Conduct Solutions Meeting with Stakeholders

The consultant will conduct one meeting with each stakeholder group to identify proposed solutions to the unmet transportation needs and issues that were identified in the previous issues meeting. The consultant will identify the best meeting format and preferred format of the meetings' output materials for each of the stakeholder groups based on the issues to be addressed and the level of technical detail needed to update the draft US 15-501 Corridor Study. The consultant will prepare materials for the meeting and produce the output materials. DCHC MPO staff will provide administration of the stakeholder groups, meeting support (e.g., documenting participant input), and, the meeting site if there is an in-person meeting.

The Durham County and Orange County transit plans are expected to be drafted or approved in the April-to-June 2021 period. The consultant will need to incorporate transit services, facilities and infrastructure from those plans into the US 15-501 Corridor Study. The staff from the DCHC MPO and its partner agencies will assist with this coordination.

- <u>Consultant will produce</u>: text, maps, conceptual designs, drawings, or any output material that that is needed to convey the ideas of the stakeholder group

Develop Draft Plan

The consultant will develop a draft conceptual design for segment 1, the I-40/US 15-501 quadrant area, and segments 2, 3, and 4 based on information from the stakeholder meetings. The DCHC MPO staff will update the summary report and full report. The consultant will present the draft conceptual design to the Project Steering Committee (PSC), the DCHC MPO Technical Committee, and finally to the DCHC MPO Board to be released for public comment. DCHC MPO staff will arrange the meetings and any electronic document distribution.

Product

- <u>Consultant will produce</u>: Draft conceptual design for segment 1, the I-40/US 15-501 quadrant area, and segment 2, 3, and 4; and, meeting presentation materials
- <u>DCHC MPO will produce</u>: Meetings, document distribution, and Web site and social medial support

Public Engagement

The consultant will develop the format and materials for a public engagement activity and conduct the engagement activity to get feedback on the conceptual design, summary report, and full report. The consultant will gather and organize the feedback. The DCHC MPO staff will administer the meeting, including: conduct public and social media notification; acquire an inperson meeting site (if the meeting is not virtual); and, document the public input.

It is expected that an in-person activity can be a single event for all three areas (i.e., segment 1, the I-40/US 15-501 quadrant area, and segments 2, 3, and 4). However, a virtual meeting will need to be divided into a separate meeting for the three areas.

- <u>Consultant will produce</u>: Materials for a public engagement activity, and document the public engagement input
- <u>DCHC MPO will produce</u>: Public and social media notification, in-person meeting facility, and Web site support

<u>Public Involvement</u>

<u>Notification</u> -- The MPO will post Amendment #3 to the MPO Web site and work with the jurisdictions and counties within the MPO to publish public affair notices. All notices will be in both English and Spanish. The MPO will push the Amendment notice through its social media channels and the MPO contact email database.

—Highway—

The table on the next page identifies updates, deletions and additions to the CTP Highway table, and is broken out by highway type, e.g., interstate, U.S. highways. Strikethrough font depicts text that is to be deleted, and **bold** font is text that is to be added. A series of maps that cover the DCHC MPO planning area follows the table. A bright green shadow, indicates which highways on the map are to be amended.

A summary of the reasons for the proposed highway updates includes:

- New Roadway Needs Some new roadway needs have been identified since the adoption of the CTP. Examples of these needs include modernization of rural roadways in Orange County and a more direct connection between US 15-501 bypass and Cole Mill Road.
- New and Discontinued Local Plans The roadway network of the recently approved Efland-Buckhorn-Mebane Access Management Plan needs to be integrated into the CTP. Roadway improvements that were based on the discontinued Durham-Orange Light Rail Transit plan can be deleted from the CTP.
- <u>New Development Impacts</u> Modifications are needed to the CTP roadway network between US 70 and NC 98 in Durham County based on new developments and site plans.


CTP Highways -- Amendment #3 -- South Durham






—Sidepaths (Complete Streets)—

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) published Complete Streets implementation guidelines that support sidepaths along major roadways. The table on the following page identifies highway segments with a "needs improvement" or "recommended" (i.e., new roadway) status that are to include a bicycle/pedestrian sidepath as an integral part of the construction and budget. The DCHC MPO has already identified many of these highway segments for sidepaths in Amendment #2 to the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP), which was adopted in November 2019.

The DCHC MPO has also identified other sidepaths that would connect to this network but these additional sidepaths are identified in the multiuse paths (MUP) table of CTP Amendment #3 because they are to be built along highways that are not designated for improvements. Note that a sidepath and multiuse path (MUP) are the same type of facility. For the sake of clarity, the CTP distinguishes a sidepath as part of a highway improvement project, and a MUP as a stand-alone bicycle/pedestrian project that in some cases might be constructed along a roadway that is not being improved.

Following the sidepath table, a series of maps that cover the DCHC MPO planning area show, using a bright purple shadow, which highways and interchanges are to have a sidepath.

In addition to the table and maps, Amendment #3 will also reference the North Carolina Complete Streets policy and guidelines to ensure that the public understands that the DCHC MPO plans to enforce Complete Streets.






CTP Sidepaths -- Amendment #3 -- Orange County (North)


—Rail, Fixed Guideway and Bus Rapid Transit—

The table and map on the next two pages identify high capacity transit and bus rapid transit (BRT) that are to be added to the CTP. The reasons for adding these project include:

- <u>Suspended Light Rail Transit</u> The suspended Durham-Orange Light Rail Transit plan left several major travel corridors without a plan to provide sufficient transit service. In place of the proposed D-O LRT, high capacity transit facilities will be implemented along the former D-O LRT corridor to connect Durham and Chapel Hill. These facilities, which the DCHC MPO added to the 2045 MTP via Amendment #2 in November 2019, will likely use differing combinations of BRT facilities such as dedicated bus lanes, enhanced bus stations, signal preemption and separate bus-only ramps at interchanges.
- Extended High Capacity Transit High capacity transit services have been extended from the Chapel Hill North-South BRT to Hillsborough, Pittsboro, and Carrboro.

A City of Durham transit plan has identified the need for three transit emphasis corridors. These improvements make it easier for the riders to get to bus stops, make them more comfortable and secure waiting for the bus, and help increase the bus speed. The facilities might include sidewalks, crosswalks, curb ramps, pavement markings, shelters, and benches, and service, and systems such as prioritized traffic signals.
