TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA)  
FOR THE DURHAM-CHAPEL HILL-CARRBORO URBAN AREA**

A motion was made by Board Member \_\_\_\_\_ and seconded by Board Member \_\_\_\_\_ for the adoption of the following resolution, and upon being put to a vote, was duly adopted.

**WHEREAS**, Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) funds are provided to DCHC MPO for projects to reduce congestion and improve air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, Surface Transportation Block Grant – Direct Attributable (STBG-DA) funds are provided to DCHC MPO for transportation projects and planning activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the DCHC MPO approved FFY17 CMAQ funds for TIP # TA-6682 on March 8, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) administers most transit projects through the FTA's Urbanized Area Formula Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, in order for local governments to receive CMAQ or STBG-DA funds for transit projects, the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) must transfer the funds to the FTA; then

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED** that the Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro Metropolitan Planning Organization Board hereby requests that the Federal Highway Administration transfer the CMAQ funds to the Federal Transit Administration for projects described on the attached table as soon as it is authorized to do so provided here on this, the 12th day of September, 2018.
